



INSTRUCTIONS FOR FINAL PAPER SUBMISSION

Final Paper Submission Deadline: **March 27, 2026**

1) Prepare the Final Version of your Paper

- We have previously sent all Authors the reviewers' remarks and suggestions in the Notification of Acceptance message. **Please consider them carefully when preparing the final version of your paper.**
- The manuscript length must be **2- to 4-pages**, formatted according to the [IEEE Manuscript Templates for Conference Proceedings](#). Further stylistic guidelines can be found in the [IEEE Editorial Style Manual for Authors](#).
- The workshop's official language is **English**. Proofread your manuscript thoroughly to ensure language and grammar are up to standard.
- Do not include page numbers and remove the copyright notice located on the manuscript's first page, bottom-left area (the IEEE Publishing Operations team will automatically assign the necessary copyright information to all conference papers).
- The manuscript final file size should not exceed **10 Mb**.

2) Mandatory Compatibility Check on PDF *eXpress*®

- Go to the [PDF *eXpress*®](#) website. Login or create an account. SPI 2026 Conference ID is 68887X.
- Submit your manuscript for checking and **save the PDF file that PDF *eXpress*® returns after a successful check** (IEEE *Xplore*® will only accept files generated by PDF *eXpress*®).

3) Transfer Copyright to IEEE

- Your paper cannot be published on IEEE *Xplore*® without a signed copyright transfer. Please note that only one author is required to sign the IEEE Copyright Agreement on behalf of all listed authors.
- Login to your *EasyChair* account and select the role "**proceedings author (IEEE SPI 2026 Proceedings volume)**". Click on the "**Sign Copyright Agreement**" button. You will be redirected to the IEEE Electronic Copyright Form (eCF) site. Follow the prompts and return to *EasyChair* once the process is complete.

4) Submit the Final Version of your Paper

- Make a final verification to ensure your paper adequately follows steps 1, 2, and 3. Papers that do not comply with all requirements cannot be included in the IEEE *Xplore*® proceedings.
- Continue in the *EasyChair* section "proceedings author" to use the option available for submission of your final paper. **Upload the PDF file returned by PDF *eXpress*®** (check step 2).

ATTENTION

- To be included in the workshop's program and submitted for inclusion into IEEE *Xplore*®, each accepted paper must have at least **one Author registered with a Regular or a Student fee paid in full by March 27, 2026** (Early Bird Deadline).
- Each registered Author may present **one paper** during the workshop.
- IEEE reserves the right to exclude a paper from distribution after the workshop, including removal from IEEE *Xplore*®, if the paper is not presented at the workshop or does not meet the scope and quality requirements for IEEE *Xplore*®.
